

Group Quarters Time Series Database

The group quarters time series database is maintained by CAAG using group quarter facilities data provided by the member agencies. The database contains living quarters that are only considered group quarters by the U.S. Census Bureau's definition. The database includes facilities, by type of facility, reported from the year 2000 to present primarily as part of the population estimates. The database is updated annually and is current as of July 1, 2009. The Pinal County group quarters time series are in the form of a shapefile using Arc GIS. Gila County group quarters time series is not in shapefile format. However group quarter population numbers are being collected and reported annually for Gila County. All data is collected and reviewed by each CAAG member agency. These files are available upon request via the CAAG license agreement.

This database does not represent a legal survey and is intended for general planning purposes only.

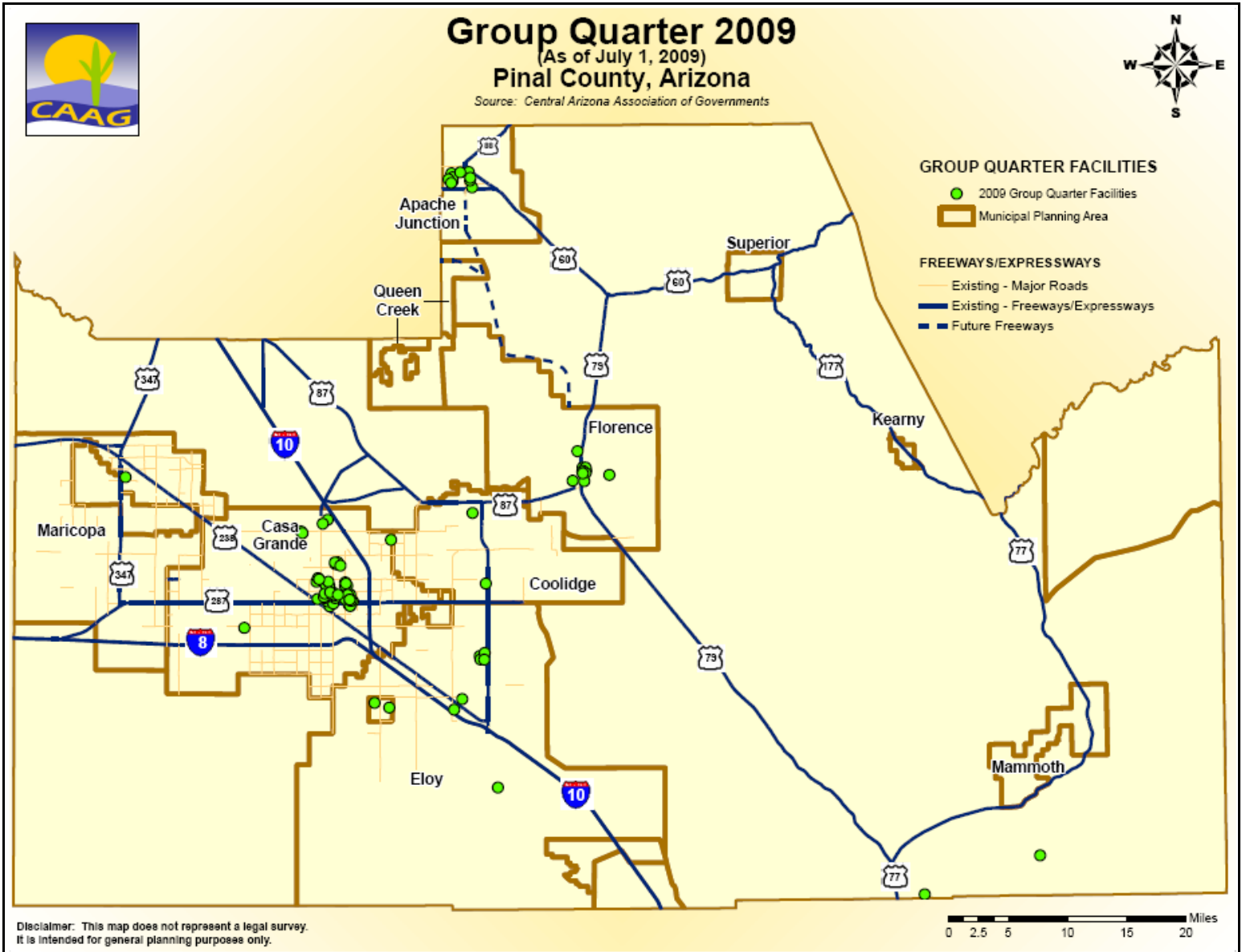
